

Dear Activ Learning and Discovery Centre member,

We are writing to advise of future changes to the Activ Learning and Discovery Centre (ALDC).

In the coming weeks, Activ will speak with a number of experienced providers in the early intervention and information services sectors to consider options for delivering the ALDC play-based and library services in the future.

The reason for seeking an alternative provider is that we believe the service would be of greatest benefit to the children and families of Western Australia when delivered in conjunction with an existing early intervention provider; a service that offers existing programs and initiatives that support childhood development and learning.

We understand that several early intervention providers currently operating in WA see the ALDC as a natural extension of the services they offer. While this transition period may be an unsettling time for members, we are committed to ensuring the quality of the ALDC service will not be affected. The needs of our customers is our priority in determining the future direction of the service.
