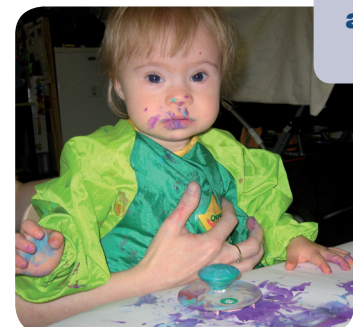

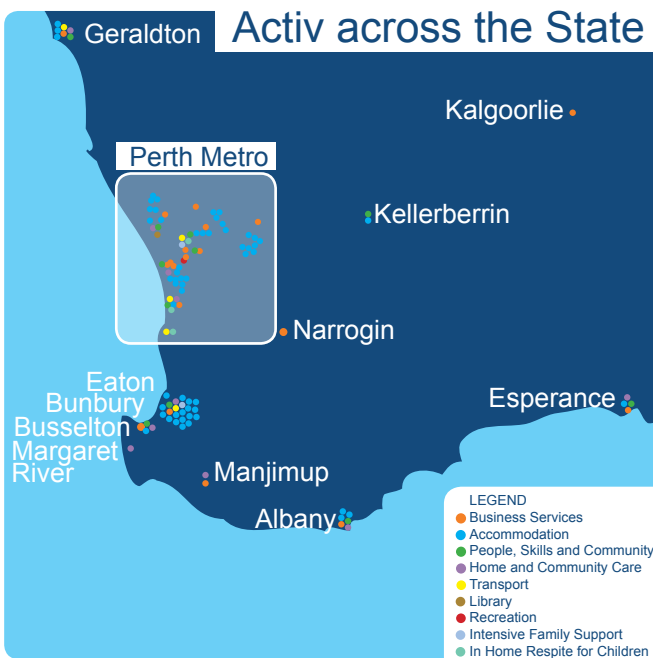
Activ has been providing services to people with disability, their parents and carers since 1951. We are driven by the possibilities of what we can deliver on our purpose – a better life.

Nearly 600 adults and children receive Accommodation and Respite services.

More than 200 people receive Alternatives to Employment Services.

775 people receive Home and Community Care support.

More than 1000 people undertake supported employment at Activ Business Services.

Approximately 500 people attend Activ Recreation holidays each year.

Nearly 500 people receive Transport Services.

Intensive Family Support is provided to 26 families.

Activ Library is a major disability library. The collection has a strong focus on intellectual disability, developmental delay and learning difficulty.

Children's Community Respite is provided to families with children aged six months to 12 years.

Over 150 people receive Activ Pathways (RTO) training each year.

How we began

Activ was formed in 1951 by a group of parents who shared a common goal to provide opportunities for their children with disabilities. Membership grew and spread across the state and began to raise money. After many appeals, donations and lobbying of government, it set up schools, workplaces, homes, transport services and recreation opportunities for people with disabilities.

Where we are now

Activ is one of the largest disability service providers in WA providing homes, drop-in support, respite, employment and alternatives to employment, home and community care, recreation, transport, training and development, intensive family support and library services. Our purpose is to enable people with disabilities and their families to pursue a better life.

Our vision for the future is to provide quality and contemporary services, enable community participation, with a focus on each individual's personal needs and aspirations.
