The collection has a strong focus on intellectual disability and also features resources related to other disabilities, developmental delay and learning difficulties.

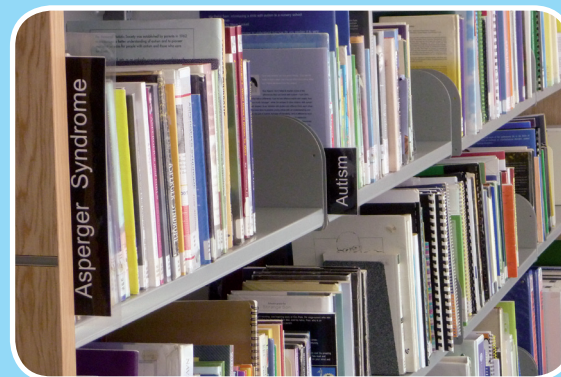
A resource for everyone
